

## Operating Engineers of Manitoba Local 987A / 987D Bursary

The annual Operating Engineers of Manitoba Local 987 – 987A / 987D Bursary is calling for applications from our 987A and 987D members. These educational bursaries are intended to provide financial assistance to OE987 members' dependents. The bursary recipients will receive a one thousand (**\$1,000.00**) bursary.

The bursary recipient must be entering the first year or subsequent of a full-time course of study (at least two (2) years in length) leading to a diploma, certificate or degree from any recognized public Canadian College, University, or Trade Program.

**Applications must be supported by transcripts (copies) of most recent marks which qualified you to enroll in a post-secondary program accompanied by proof (copy) of registration from the Community College, University, or Trade Program for the upcoming term along with any certificates, diplomas, letters of recommendation, or any other information to assist the decision process. In addition, applicants must submit a short essay (500-word maximum) on why they think they would be a good candidate for the bursary and also a short essay (750-word maximum) giving their views and ideas on what they think the role of unions are in our society.**

The deadline for receipt of the applications is **October 1<sup>st</sup> by 5:00 P.M.**

The decision process will be handled by the Bursary Selection Committee.

- 4) Attach a short essay (500-word maximum) about yourself stating why you believe you are a good candidate for this bursary. Include such things as your community involvement, special activities and interests, future goals, etc.
- 5) Attach a short essay (750-word maximum) giving your views and ideas on what you think the role of unions is in our society.
